On behalf of the undersigned student clubs and activities and the undersigned UCL alumni we wish to register our complaint about the unjustified removal of the traditional permanent dojo and the manner in which this was carried out. We believe that incomplete and therefore misleading information was provided by the new BF Manager to the student officers regarding usage and function of the traditional dojo and regarding Squash usage. It appears that there was consultation with the Squash Club but the many clubs and activities and the individual members who used the permanent dojo were not only not consulted but also kept in the dark of the plans for change.

We request that the Dojo be restored this summer, in time for the start of the new academic year.

We would prefer the Dojo to be restored in its (quieter) old room, opposite the south staircase (now Court B). However, because of the problems that we have had in laying the mats in such a way that there are no gaps between them, we have found that the current multi-purpose room (old Squash Court B) does not, according to our measurements, in fact conform to contemporary WSF standards for match court size. Its value to the Squash Club is therefore questionable.
